

Program and Policies Information

Registration: Registration forms are on page 16. Registration is based on a first come-first served, PAID basis or certificate of eligibility. Online registrations are accepted at www.rsu25.maineadulted.org using a credit or debit card. You can also fill out our registration form and drop it off at our office, fax to 469-2192, or mail the form. Check, cash, money order, credit or debit cards are accepted, but please do not mail cash. Pre-registration is required unless otherwise indicated to allow instructors to prepare materials and prevent course cancellations or overbooking.

When registering, please notify staff regarding any information we may need while you are enrolled with us (i.e. allergies, accommodations, etc.). Individuals with a disability who may need accommodations are requested to contact Kathy Pelletier, Director, at least two weeks in advance of the event, so that appropriate accommodations/arrangements may be made.

Registration Confirmations: No confirmation will be sent unless there are course changes or if you have not enrolled early enough to meet the course enrollment minimum. When pre-registering by phone, you will be put on our waiting list until payment has been received. ***In order to secure a seat in the class, payment, certificate of eligibility or training approval MUST be made at time of registration.***

Refunds: If we cancel a class, all fees will be refunded. Unless a class has been filled, has only the minimum number necessary, or indicates otherwise, if you withdraw before the second class, all course fees will be refunded. There are no refunds for missed one-night workshops.

Course Cancellations: We reserve the right to cancel a class due to insufficient enrollment or other circumstances. Please register early to avoid disappointment.

Weather Cancellations: Adult Education cancels all classes when RSU 25 School District cancels classes due to snow or adverse weather conditions. 


HiSET®


High School Completion







Computer and Technology

IC3 Training

IC3 is a certification for anyone who wants to demonstrate critical computer and internet skills. It can be taken as part of our computer support program or a stand alone course. Students who achieve IC3 certification possess the validated skills and knowledge required for basic use of computer hardware, software, networks, and the Internet. Not only do you receive tools for success in the 21st Century classroom but also for higher education, employment, and life. To become IC3 certified, you must pass 3 level exams. The course includes training and practice tests. Certification exams are held after you successfully complete the course and pass the practice exam. Schedule set with student upon enrollment.

Northstar Digital Literacy Certificate

The Northstar Digital Literacy Certificate is a self-guided online set of assessments that shows an individual's ability to perform basic computer skills. Assessments are available for basic computer skills, world wide web, Windows, Mac OSX, email, Word, social media, Excel, Powerpoint, and information literacy. Testing for a certificate is free and available to anyone who needs to assess their skills. Lab times vary each semester or may be set up by appointment. Please note that there is a fee for instructor-led courses. You can call our office at 469-2129 to set up an appointment or to learn more about the program.



Healthcare

CCMA (Certified Clinical Medical Assistant)

Do you want to prepare for an exciting, challenging and rewarding career in healthcare? We train students to assist physicians by performing functions related to the clinical responsibilities of a medical office. Instructions includes preparing patients for examination and treatment, routine laboratory procedures, diagnostic testing, technical aspects of phlebotomy and the cardiac life cycle. Students will review important topics including medical terminology, Anatomy & Physiology, electronic health records, medical billing and coding, phlebotomy, pharmacology, the proper use and administration of medications, taking and documenting vital signs, cardiology including proper EKG lead placements, professional workplace behavior, ethics and the legal aspects of healthcare. This program is offered as part of Strengthening Maine's Workforce MJRP Adult Education grants. Enrollment is an application process. Accepted students will work with Adult Education and partner programs to provide this course free of charge. Classes will be hybrid (onsite and live online) with onsite labs at multiple locations. Interested students must be prepared to be live on camera via zoom with a working microphone for class hours on Mondays and Thursdays. Upon successful completion of our program, students will be eligible to take a national certification exam, and have an opportunity for job shadowing/externship.
